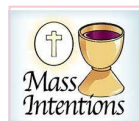

**HEALTHY VS. UNHEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS**

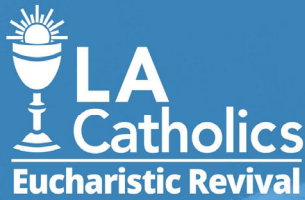
