# Eucharistic Miracle of Pope St. Gregory the Great

In Rome, Italy in 595 A.D., a Eucharistic miracle occurred involving Pope St. Gregory the Great.


In those days, it was customary to have the Eucharistic bread prepared by the parishioners.

One Sunday, while celebrating the Mass in an ancient church dedicated to St. Peter, the Pope was distributing Communion. In line, he saw one of the women who had prepared the bread for the consecration. He was disturbed to observe her laughing out loud.

The Pope pulled her aside and asked her to explain her behavior. She justified herself by saying that she could not believe that the bread she made with her very own hands could become the Body and Blood of Christ during the consecration. Pope Gregory denied her Communion and prayed for God to cast His light upon her.

As he concluded his prayer for her to believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, he saw that part of the bread prepared by the woman became Flesh and Blood.

The woman repented, knelt on the ground and began to cry. To this day, part of the relic of the miracle is housed in Andechs, Germany, near the local Benedictine monastery.










### APOSTLES CREED




